**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO TENTH DISTRICT COURT  
OF APPEALS**

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Betsy Luper Schuster of New Albany (Franklin Co.) to serve as a judge on the Tenth District Court of Appeals. Schuster will assume office on January 27, 2014, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends February 9, 2019. Schuster is replacing the late Judge Peggy Bryant, who retired.

Schuster received a Bachelor of Arts degree from The Ohio State University and earned her juris doctorate from The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law. Since 2011, she has served as chief elections counsel for the Ohio Secretary of State's Office.

Schuster has previously served as commissioner for the Ohio Court of Claims Crime Victims Division and as hearing officer for the Ohio Department of Education, The Ohio State University, the Ohio Board of Cosmetology, and the Ohio Department of Public Safety. She has served as adjunct professor at Capital University Law School and The Ohio State University Moritz College of Law. Schuster has also served Ohio as chief legal counsel and deputy chief legal counsel in the Office of the Governor and as assistant attorney general in the Office of the Attorney General.
