LEGISLATION SIGNED BY GOVERNOR

COLUMBUS – Today, Gov. John R. Kasich signed the following pieces of legislation into law:

Sub. H.B. 14 (Sears) removes pit bulls from the definition of “vicious dog” in state law;

Sub. H.B. 32 (Amstutz) exempts certain plans and measurements relating to household sewage treatment systems from the Professional Engineers and Surveyors Law;

Am. H.B. 185 (O’Brien) designates the third week of July as “Ohio Aggregates and Industrial Minerals Awareness Week;”

Am. H.B. 212 (Grossman) extends legal custodians the exemption from certain adoptive placement requirements;

Am. H.B. 215 (Dovilla) designates the fifteenth day of June as “Elder Abuse Awareness Day” to increase public awareness of the innocent victims of elder abuse;

Sub. H.B. 267 (McKenney) adopts the Revised Uniform Unincorporated Nonprofit Association Act and revises the merger and consolidation provisions of Nonprofit Corporation Law; and

Sub. H.B. 268 (Szollosi, Butler) modernizes the language of, reorganizes, and removes obsolete provisions from the jury service law.
