**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO CUYAHOGA COUNTY COMMON
PLEAS COURT**

Today Gov. John Kasich announced the appointment of Joan Synenberg of Cleveland (Cuyahoga Co.) to serve as Judge of the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court. Synenberg will assume office on Monday, March 4, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for a full term, which ends January 11, 2017.

Synenberg received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Cleveland State University and earned her juris doctorate from the Cleveland-Marshall College of Law. She has been serving Cuyahoga County as a judge since 2005.

Synenberg has been actively involved in her community, being featured as a guest speaker for organizations such as the Lakewood Kiwanis, FitGirl Wellness Camp, and the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers. She is also a board member for the AIDS Task Force of Greater Cleveland and the Cleveland-Marshall College of Law Alumni Association.
