LEGISLATION SIGNED BY GOVERNOR

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich signed the following pieces of legislation into law:

Am. Sub. S.B. 83 (Oelslager, Tavares) modifies the authority of certain advanced practice nurses to prescribe schedule II controlled substances and to authorize the Board of Nursing to take disciplinary actions for self-administration of schedule I controlled substances;

S.B. 247 (Balderson) designates July 9th as "Traumatic Brain Injury Awareness Day";

Am. S.B. 258 (Manning, Patton) to create the Statewide Blue Alert Program to assist in the apprehension of persons suspected of killing or seriously injuring law enforcement officers and to aid in the location of missing law enforcement officers; and

Am. Sub. S.B. 223 (Bacon) which allows the Attorney General to investigate the offenses of unauthorized use of property and telecommunications fraud and to modify the penalties for telecommunications fraud.
