KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE TENTH DISTRICT COURT OF APPEALS

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Amy C. O’Grady of Columbus (Franklin Co.) to serve as a judge on the Tenth District Court of Appeals. O’Grady will assume office on June 3, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2016. O’Grady is replacing Judith French, who was appointed to the Supreme Court of Ohio.

O’Grady graduated from Kent State University in 1996, and earned her juris doctorate from Capital University Law School in 2000. Since 2005, she has worked for the Ohio Attorney General’s Office in Crime Victim Services.

O’Grady is a representative on the Ohio Jail Advisory Board. She is also a coordinator for the Ohio Attorney General’s Task Force on Criminal Justice and Mental Illness, and served as a trustee for the National Alliance on Mental Illness of Ohio from 2006 to 2010.
