KASICH PRAISES LEGISLATURE FOR PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL 487

COLUMBUS—Today Gov. John R. Kasich released the following statement in response to the General Assembly’s adoption of House Bill 487 (Amstutz):

“We started the Mid-Biennium Review process several months ago in order to improve the way government operates so it can be a better steward of taxpayers’ resources.
