**KASICH SIGNS FIVE BILLS INTO LAW**

COLUMBUS—Today Gov. John R. Kasich signed the following pieces of legislation into law:

**Am. Sub. H.B. 85** (Terhar & Gonzales) enhances the homestead exemption for military veterans who are 100% disabled from a service-connected disability;

**H. B. 105** (Hayes) designates the calendar week including the seventeenth of July as “Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Week;”

**H.B. 171** (McClain & Patmon) permits public school students to attend and receive credit for released-time courses in religious instruction conducted off school property during regular school hours;

**H.B. 264** (Wachtmann & Barnes) improves care for students with diabetes in schools;

**H.B. 362** (Scherer & Derickson) authorizes the STEM Committee to grant a designation of STEM school equivalent to a community school or chartered nonpublic school, to make other revisions to the law regarding STEM schools, and modifies standards for teacher evaluations.
