**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Jane Margaret Davis of Hudson (Summit Co.) to serve as a judge on the Summit County Court of Common Pleas, General Division. Davis will assume office on July 8, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the remainder of the unexpired term, which ends January 4, 2017.

Davis received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics and a Masters of Arts degree in Industrial Relations from the University of Cincinnati, and earned her juris doctorate from the University of Akron School of Law. Since 2005, she has practiced law as a self-employed attorney and has previously served as magistrate of the Stark County Court of Common Pleas.
