KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE CLEVELAND MUNICIPAL COURT

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Charles J. Bauernschmidt of Bratenahl (Cuyahoga Co.) to serve as a judge on the Cleveland Municipal Court. Bauernschmidt will assume office on July 17, 2013, replacing Michael J. Ryan, who was elected to Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court.

Bauernschmidt received a Bachelor of Arts degree in History from Rollins College, and earned his juris doctorate from Case Western Reserve Law School. Since 2002, he has served as magistrate for the Village of Bratenahl.
