KASICH DENIES CLEMENCY FOR HARRY MITTS, JR.

COLUMBUS – Gov. John R. Kasich has denied a request for executive clemency from Harry Mitts, Jr., who in 1994 was convicted of the aggravated murders of Garfield Heights police officer Sgt. Dennis Glivar and John A. Bryant in Cuyahoga County.

Mitts is scheduled to be executed on September 25, 2013, at the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility in Lucasville, Ohio. On August 27, 2013, the Ohio Parole Board unanimously recommended against clemency for Mitts.
