**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO THE MADISON COUNTY COURT OF
COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Governor John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Eamon P. Costello of Plain City (Madison Co.) to serve as a judge on the Madison County Court of Common Pleas, General/Domestic Relations Division. Costello will assume office on November 1, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for the unexpired term, which ends December 31, 2016. Costello is replacing Judge Robert D. Nichols, who announced his retirement effective October 31, 2013.

Costello received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from Wright State University, and earned his juris doctorate from the University of Toledo College of Law. Since 1996, he has served as the assistant prosecuting attorney for the Madison County Prosecutor's Office.

Costello is a member of the National District Attorneys Association and has worked as the village solicitor for Plain City since 2011. He began his career at the Greene County Prosecutor's Office shortly after graduating from law school.
