**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO CUYAHOGA COUNTY DOMESTIC
RELATIONS COURT**

Today Gov. John Kasich announced the appointment of Janet R. Colaluca of Bratenahl (Cuyahoga Co.) to serve as Judge of the Cuyahoga County Domestic Relations Court. Colaluca will assume office on January 7, 2013, and must run in November 2014 to retain the seat for a full term which ends January 12, 2017.

Colaluca received a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree from John Carroll University and earned her juris doctorate from Cleveland-Marshall College of Law. Since 2006, she has served as magistrate to the Village of Bratenahl Mayor's Court, and has worked at the Colaluca Law Firm, LLC. since January 2012.

Colaluca has been involved in such organizations as the Junior League of Cleveland, Health Hill Children's Hospital, and the Ronald McDonald House, and is also a founding member of the Executive Women's Steering Committee at The Club at Society Center.
