The opiate crisis requires a comprehensive approach and the recent review of the acute pain opioid

prescribing rules by CSI is one piece of the potential solution. The rules are going through the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review now and will become effective soon to reduce misuse and abuse of opiate prescribing in Ohio.
