Lieutenant Governor Mary Taylor joined the CSI Small Business Advisory Council in Chillicothe this week. Representatives from the Ohio Department of Education and the Ohio Development Services Agency shared the state's work on career technical education and small business assistance programs, respectively. There was much discussion around how to ensure that our graduates receive the training they need for careers that are in high-demand in their regions, while also providing resources to entrepreneurs to guide them through the process of setting up their businesses in Ohio. Finally, Lt. Governor Taylor addressed the group and took questions from the audience along with ideas for what can be done to help businesses continue to succeed in Ohio.



Also this week, Lieutenant Governor Taylor addressed her work on the Great Lakes Economic Task Force with the Greater Cleveland International Lawyers Group. Ohio plays a large role in the regional economy and one of our greatest assets is Lake Erie. The task force is focused on efforts related to cross-border trade, economic clusters, and enhancing regional productivity.
