KASICH DENIES CLEMENCY REQUEST FOR CHARLES LORRAINE

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich denied a request for executive clemency for Charles Lorraine, who was convicted in 1986 of murdering Raymond and Doris Montgomery in Trumbull County.

Lorraine is scheduled to be executed on January 18th at the Southern Ohio Correctional Facility in Lucasville. In December, the Ohio Parole Board unanimously recommended against clemency for Lorraine.
