**KASICH ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENT TO SUMMIT COUNTY COURT
OF COMMON PLEAS**

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Amy Corrigan Jones of Akron (Summit Co.) to serve as Judge of the Summit County Court of Common Pleas, General Division. Corrigan Jones will assume office on January 20, and must run in November 2012 in order to start service on a full term commencing January 2, 2013.

Corrigan Jones received a bachelor's degree in psychology from Kent State University and earned her juris doctorate from the University of Akron School of Law. Since 2006, she has served as managing partner at Corrigan & Jones, Attorneys at Law. Her professional experience has specialized in civil litigation, as well as defense and plaintiff's litigation.
