KASICH APPOINTS TENOGLIA TO MEIGS COUNTY COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Christopher Tenoglia of Reedsville (Meigs Co.) to serve as Judge of the Meigs County Court of Common Pleas, General and Domestic Relations Divisions. Tenoglia will assume office on January 23 and must run in November 2012 in order to start service on a full term commencing January 1, 2013.

Tenoglia received a bachelor's degree in communications from Ohio University and earned his juris doctorate from the University of Toledo College of Law. Tenoglia is admitted to practice law in Ohio and the United States District Court, Southern District of Ohio. Since 1996, he has operated a private law practice and has served as the law director for the Village of Pomeroy. Tenoglia previously served as the Meigs Co. assistant prosecuting attorney for 10 years.

Tenoglia is a member of the Ohio State and Meigs County Bar Associations, and is a life member of the Ohio State Bar Foundation.
