KASICH ISSUES RESOLUTION HONORING LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS
Resolution Observes Peace Officers' Memorial Day and Police Week

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich issued a resolution urging all Ohioans to honor Ohio's law enforcement officials who have been lost in the line of duty. Peace Officers' Memorial Day is Sunday, May 15, and in accordance with a proclamation from the President of the United States of America, Gov. Kasich ordered that all flags be flown at half-staff on all state-owned property and encouraged flags to be displayed at half-staff in homes and businesses.

Sunday also marks the beginning of Police Week (May 15-21). This is a time for everyone to pay homage to our fallen heroes, reflect on the sacrifices made by these officers and their families, and thank all law enforcement officials for the courageous work they do to keep our communities safe.
