KASICH APPOINTS ADKINS TO MONTGOMERY COUNTY COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Dennis J. Adkins of Dayton (Montgomery Co.) to serve as Judge of the Montgomery County Court of Common Pleas. Adkins will assume office on June 6, 2011 and must run in November 2012 in order to serve out the remainder of the unexpired term ending June 30, 2015.

Adkins earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Dayton and his juris doctor from the Salmon P. Chase College of Law at Northern Kentucky University. He is admitted to practice law in Ohio, the U.S. District Court, and the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals. Since 1991, Adkins has been a practicing attorney at the law firm of Altick & Corwin Co., L.P.A. (Dayton). He has also served as an acting judge in the Kettering Municipal Court since 1993 and has 15 years combined experience as a special prosecutor in several cities.

Adkins is a member of the American Bar Association, the Ohio State Bar Association, the Dayton Bar Association, the Ohio Academy of Trial Lawyers, the American Trial Lawyers Association and the Ohio Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers. He has served as a lecturer for Dayton-area public schools, the University of Dayton Law School, and the Dayton Bar Association.
