KASICH SIGNS HOUSE BILL 95 – UTILITY REGULATION MODERNIZATION

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich signed House Bill 95 (Stautberg), legislation modernizing Ohio’s utility regulation environment and providing incentives to increase investment in utilities, while preserving safeguards to protect ratepayers. This legislation received bipartisan support in both chambers of the Ohio General Assembly.

Key provisions in HB 95 will change public notice requirements for rate cases for all utility providers, permit certain rate-calculation adjustments for natural gas companies, allow applications for natural gas company capital expenditure programs and adjustments to natural gas revenue requirements, and make other regulatory changes concerning audits, alternative rate plans, and forecast reports. With the passage of HB 95, PUCO will continue to maintain regulatory oversight and assure safe and reliable utility service at a fair price.
