**KASICH APPOINTS ROSEBROOK TO NAPOLEON MUNICIPAL COURT**

COLUMBUS - Today Gov. John R. Kasich announced the appointment of Amy C. Rosebrook of Napoleon (Henry Co.) to serve as Judge of the Napoleon Municipal Court. Rosebrook will assume office on July 1, 2011 and will serve out the remainder of the unexpired term ending Dec. 31, 2011. She must run in November 2011 to retain the seat and start service for the full six-year term beginning January 1, 2012.

Rosebrook earned her bachelor's degree from Ohio University and her juris doctor from the University of Toledo, College of Law. She is admitted to practice in Ohio and the U.S. District Court Northern District of Ohio. Rosebrook began practicing law in 1998 and has been a partner at the law firm of Hanna, Fisher & Rosebrook since 2003. Additionally, Rosebrook has served as Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for Henry County since 2000. In this capacity, she handles civil and township matters, criminal appeals, felony prosecutions, and currently represents the Children Services Agency.

Rosebrook currently serves as President of the Henry County Bar Association, and is a member of the Ohio Bar Association and the Association of Family and Conciliation Courts.
