Orders Flags in Franklin County to be Flown at Half-Staff

COLUMBUS – Today Gov. John R. Kasich issued a resolution recognizing the service of Franklin County Sheriff James Karnes who passed away last week. Gov. Kasich ordered that all flags be flown at half-staff on all state-owned property in Franklin County on Wednesday, June 8.

Sheriff Karnes was the longest-serving sheriff in Franklin County history, spending more than 18 years on the job and a total of 48 years in public service. For nearly five decades, Sheriff Karnes earned the respect of his peers and was an admired member of the law enforcement community throughout Ohio and across the country.
