EXECUTIVE ORDER SIGNED BY GOVERNOR

COLUMBUS – Today, Gov. John R. Kasich signed Executive Order 2012-01K which allows the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to immediately amend rules impacting permitting exemptions for greenhouse gas emissions from biomass facilities to match United States EPA rules in scope and intent. The Executive Order will prevent Ohio facilities from having to initiate a permitting process and spend funds that they would not otherwise be required to spend.
