**EXECUTIVE ORDER SIGNED BY GOVERNOR**

COLUMBUS – Today, Gov. John R. Kasich signed **Executive Order 2011-30K** that directs the expenditure of \$6,539,371.00 in Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) funds by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for Fiscal Year 2012. The funds will be allocated as follows:

1. Up to one million dollars to partner with After-School All-Stars to enhance after-school enrichment programs for low-income, at-risk children.
2. Up to two million dollars to assist the Ohio Association of Second Harvest Foodbanks with increasing the amounts of food for emergency use in poverty-stricken areas of the state.

The remaining amount will be used to support programs or organizations that promote the mission of the Governor's Office of Faith-Based and Community Initiatives in accordance with TANF program guidelines.
