**Governor-elect Kasich Appoints Joe Testa Ohio Tax  
Commissioner**

NEWARK – Today Governor-elect John Kasich appointed former Franklin County Auditor Joe Testa to be the Tax Commissioner for the State of Ohio.

Wray is a nationally-recognized transportation expert.. From 1991-1999, Wray served as Director of ODOT under Governors Taft and Voinovich, and was instrumental in helping the Department become leaner and more efficient, saving future payrolls more than \$50 million annually. Under Director Wray's leadership, ODOT increased its construction program by \$300 million from its output in the 1980's while simultaneously reducing its operating costs by \$200 million and its workforce by 1,800 employees.

Kasich announced the nomination at a press conference in Wray's hometown of Newark, in Licking County. Wray is the fifth agency director nominated by Kasich since being elected governor on November 2.
