**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, since the founding of our nation, tens of millions of Americans have served in the Armed Forces and traveled to all corners of the globe to defend our nation in times of war and protect our freedom in times of peace; and

**WHEREAS**, a century ago, 4.7 million Americans, over 154,000 from Ohio, fought and sacrificed on the seas, in the air, and on foreign soil in the Great War to make the world safe for democracy; and

**WHEREAS**, after 1564 days of fighting, on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month in 1918, the allied nations and Germany signed an armistice, bringing World War I to an end; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1919, President Woodrow Wilson signed a proclamation declaring November 11 as Armistice Day to commemorate the agreement signed a year earlier; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1954, Armistice Day would be renamed Veterans Day to commemorate the service and sacrifice of all veterans; and

**WHEREAS**, nothing that we say or do can fully express the depths of our gratitude for the historic service and sacrifice of our World War I veterans or the brave men and women of our armed forces; and


**WHEREAS**, as a reminder of the price we pay for the freedom we cherish, we have an obligation to honor the valor and service of each and every veteran.
