Ohio's natural resources are one of the many factors that make it a great place to invest and do business. Two international companies recently announced a partnership which supports that vision. South Korean Daelim Industrial recently announced its intention to join Thailand-based PTT Global Chemical in establishing an ethane cracker plant in Belmont County Ohio. The announcement follows extensive planning and cooperation between PTT and JobsOhio, and would double the investment in the facility, up to approximately \$10 billion. PTT has already spent \$150 million on design work for the proposed facility and clean-up of the site. Lt. Governor Mary Taylor is proud of her role in bringing this project that will create hundreds of jobs to fruition including meetings with PTT leaders this past autumn in both Columbus and Washington D.C., where the group was welcomed by President Trump at the White House.
